## What is the IB Diploma Programme?

The IB Diploma Programme is a two-year curriculum sequence that promotes students' total development by offering them challenging academic experiences and intellectual depth across the academic disciplines while cultivating their personal growth, international/global-mindedness, and leadership. Students who complete the requirements of the programme are eligible (based upon their performance on assessments) to be awarded the Diploma of the International Baccalaureate (more commonly called the "IB Diploma.")

### Why do WKHS students choose the IB Diploma Programme?

IB courses offer a classroom experience that is built around student interest and inquiry  
IB courses emphasize global interconnections and the contributions of people of many cultures  
IB courses in all academic disciplines develop students' research, thinking, and writing skills  
IB courses are designed to promote students' intellectual growth at a reasonable pace  
IB students form a tight-knit family and develop individual relationships with their teachers  
IB students explore the nature of knowledge in the Theory of Knowledge course  
IB students embrace a lifestyle of self-improvement and reflection in  
Creativity-Activity-Service  
IB students complete a work of independent research and writing called the Extended Essay  
IB students leave WKHS with the highest level of preparation for university-level work  
IB students gain an advantage in university admissions and may receive university credit

### What options are available for participation in the IB Diploma Programme at WKHS?

Students who wish to pursue the full IB Diploma Programme and attempt to earn the IB Diploma are called "IB Diploma Programme Students";

Students who wish to experience the benefits of the IB Diploma Programme but may not be able to complete all of its requirements are encouraged to consider enrollment as an "IB Partial Program Student"; see requirements on the back of this page.

Students who wish to take IB courses as "stand-alone" courses may do so; see requirements of "IB Course Students" on the back of this page.

You must complete one from <u>all</u> of the six groups below (three HL and three SL)			
Group 1: Language and Literature	English Literature HL (2 years)		
Group 2: Language Acquisition	French HL (2 years); Latin SL (2 years); Spanish HL (2 years)		
Group 3: Individuals and Societies	History SL (1.5 years) or HL (2 years); Psychology SL (1 year)		
Group 4: Sciences	Biology SL (1 year)		
Group 5: Mathematics	Mathematics SL Applications and Interpretation (2 years) Mathematics HL Analysis and Approaches (2 years)		
Group 6: Electives	Visual Arts SL (1 year), Business Management SL (1 year) or HL (2 years) or a second course from Groups 1-5 above		
Must also complete: Creativity-Action-Service (CAS); Extended Essay; Theory of Knowledge

### IB Partial Program Student requirements

Complete at least <u>two</u> IB courses from Groups 1-6 above
Complete Theory of Knowledge; complete <u>either</u> Creativity-Action-Service <u>or</u> Extended Essay
Not eligible for IB Diploma
2018-2019 cost to family (may increase slightly over next two years): \$410

### IB Course Student requirements

Complete any number of the IB courses from Groups 1-6 above; complete all assessments required by the instructor
Not eligible for IB Diploma
2018-2019 cost to family (may increase slightly over next two years): \$291 for one exam; \$410 for two or more exams
