Our school hours are 7:40-2:20 for All Day Kindergarten and grades 1-5. Half Day Kindergarten hours are 11:30-2:20. Please report any absences or late arrivals to the school office at 614-450-5400 as early as possible. This line has 24-hour voicemail for absence reporting.

Please see the enclosed information sheets with our district, school, and related calendars, as well as other helpful information about school fees, signing students out of the building, volunteering, and when to keep an ill child home from school, and PTA forms for membership, school directory, and signing up to be a room parent. We do ask all families complete the Emergency Data Review in Infinite Campus as soon as possible (instructions enclosed). These informational items will also be printed and sent home for all families during our Meet the Teacher/PTA Ice Cream Social event.

Teacher assignments for grades 1-5 will be sent via email on Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup> between 4 and 6 p.m.

Families new to the district will receive their parental username and passwords via US Mail in early August. Existing families can retrieve their username and passwords by clicking on Password Recovery Link under Quick Links on the Worthington Schools website.

Our cafeteria will be start serving breakfast and lunch beginning Wednesday, August 16<sup>th</sup> for grades 1-5 and Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup> for all day kindergarten students. Please apply for the Free/Reduced Meals program electronically under the Organization/Food Service tab on the Worthington Schools website. A new application is required each school year.

Monday, August 14th from 4:00-6:00 is our Meet the Teacher Ice Cream Social event hosted by the PTA. This is a time where students have the opportunity to visit their classroom and meet their new teacher. You are also welcome to bring student supplies to school at this time. If you ordered supplies from the school sale, they will be delivered to the classroom labeled with your child's name.

After you visit your child's classroom, stop by the multipurpose room to reconnect with your friends and pick up an ice cream treat! There will be informational tables set up for different activities and information regarding ordering spirit wear!

#### **NEW FAMILY ORIENTATION**

Each year, our PTA holds a new family orientation meeting. Please join us on Tuesday, August 29th from 6-7:30 p.m. This is a time where a representative from the PTA provides new families with a general overview of Colonial Hills, school functions and the way things work. Families also have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have.

<u>DROP OFF AND PICK UP INFORMATION:</u> Please review the enclosed traffic pattern for arrival and dismissal. Please follow these directions to help our arrival and dismissal process run smoothly. Please keep in mind that these procedures are designed to keep our students safe. Our goal is for cars to pull up, students get out of the car quickly and efficiently and for the line to keep moving as smoothly as possible.

Key things to remember:

- 1. Traffic flows one way westwardly on Colonial for drop off and pick up
- 2. Please wait patiently in the drop off line and do not pull around cars that are taking longer to unload
- 3. PARENTS at drop off, please **do not** get out of the car to help your child out of the car. Have them ready with their backpack when you pull up to the curb so that they can quickly exit the vehicle on the curb side only.
- 4. Please do not pull into a driveway and back up and pull out to go the other direction to avoid waiting in the line. You can't always see if a little one is walking or running behind your car. This is very unsafe and you will probably see me trying to chase you down in your rear-view mirror (this is not pretty) to ask you not to do that.
- 5. If you have other individuals that are not familiar with our procedures picking your student(s) up, please explain the procedures to them.
- 6. FINALLY, please do not drop your student off or allow them to walk to school prior to 7:30.

#### **DISMISSAL INFORMATION**

We need to know what your plans are for your child for dismissal. You will receive an email with a link to complete a Google Form so that you can let us know what your child's dismissal plans are. For example, if your child is a bus rider at dismissal, you will indicate that on the form. If your child walks home every day, please indicate that. It is always very important to let the office know if your child's dismissal plans are changing for the day. For example, if your child typically rides the bus home but is walking home with a friend, you will need to call the office and let us know. Please call the office with changes to dismissal plans by 2:00 that day. As you can imagine the office gets busy at the end of the day and early notification helps to prevent chaos after school. For safety purposes, we are not able to deviate from your child's dismissal plan without a note or call to the office.

#### **BUILDING VISITS AND STUDENT SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT:**

Worthington Schools will be using the online SchoolSafeID electronic sign in / sign out visitor system again this school year. Every visitor and volunteer that enters the building will be asked to check in using this system. This is also how we track student sign in and sign outs. The first time you sign in, you will need your driver's license or state issued ID. You can download a pass on any smartphone and use the pass to check in on subsequent visits. Thank you for your cooperation with this. The safety of our students is very important to us.

#### **BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS:**

Worthington Schools asks that we do not celebrate student birthdays with food in the classroom. Please do not send in cookies, cupcakes, candy or other food items with your child to share with

classmates. If you would like to send in something for your child to share with their classmates on their birthday, please consider sending stickers, pencils, trinkets, etc. or plan a special activity such as reading a book or playing a game.

Snacks will be served throughout the year during scheduled celebrations. Families will always be informed when food will be brought into classrooms so that alternate plans can be made for students with dietary restrictions.

#### **FOOD IN SCHOOL**

Please remember that all Worthington schools are nut free. For the safety of our students, DO NOT send food to school that may contain peanuts or tree nuts. Keep this in mind for school lunches and any snacks that you may send if your teacher has a scheduled snack time. This also pertains to school parties.



#### Dear Colonial Hills Families:

Due to some feedback from families regarding safety and observations made by myself and other staff, I would like to try something different with our drop off this year. Obviously, my primary goal is to always make sure student safety is the priority while hopefully making the morning routine more efficient and less chaotic. Here are the important points to note:

- School hours this year are 7:40-2:20.
  - Bus drop off will be at 7:30
  - Car drop off and walker arrival will be at 7:30
- Greenwich will be closed to car traffic at drop off and dismissal (daycare vans only).
- Drop off traffic will flow one way following the arrows.
- Parents should pull up to the curb along the north side of Colonial, stopping only long enough for students to get out of the car and then proceed forward. Parents should not park on Colonial and get out of the car with students. Traffic should flow west on Colonial, parents will pull up to the curb and students should exit the car only on the curb side.
- When pulling up for drop off, students need to be ready to exit the car (curb side only).
   They should have their backpack in hand and be ready to go!
- If you would like to park your car and walk your student up to the intersection to drop them off, you can park on Greenwich south of Park Blvd.
- There will be a staff member on duty in the morning and after school at the top of the ravine at South Field for families who would like to use that area for drop off and pick up (I strongly encourage this as it helps reduce congestion at the Colonial/Greenwich intersection).
- We will continue to ask parents who walk students to school to say goodbye at the corner/intersection of Colonial and Greenwich.
- For now, dismissal procedures will remain the same as previous years (with the exception Greenwich being closed). Walkers and car riders will be walked out at 2:20.







Additionally, families may qualify for a full or partial waiver of classroom fees and kindergarten tuition-please complete a Free/Reduced meals application to determine if your family qualifies for a waiver. Families will receive a written notification of qualifying benefits, if applicable.

Families may deposit funds for student meals through MyPaymentsPlus (MPP). MyPaymentsPlus is linked on the Worthington Schools website under "Parent Resources".

# 2023-2024 SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONAL FEES

The Worthington School district asks parents to contribute a little more than other residents for the cost of educating their children. There are additional costs for reading and math materials and other consumable supplies that are used in areas such as art, math, science and handwriting. The fees vary by grade level as the types of materials are different.

The money collected for these materials will be deposited in a school supplies fund that serves your school. These funds will enable us to provide your child's teacher with materials the classroom.

The fee schedule for the 2023-2024 school year is:

Kindergarten = \$24 | Grades 1, 2 & 3 = \$42 | Grades 4 & 5 = \$36

You may pay your child's school fees with a credit or debit card using My Payments Plus. You may also write a check, made payable to Colonial Hills Elementary School. Please be sure to write your child's name and "school fees" on the memo line so we may credit the correct account. If paying by cash, please put in an envelope with your child's full name and grade written on the envelope.



The district is now utilizing the School Safe ID system. This new system offers a fast, simple way to electronically register and review individuals who visit our schools and who need to sign students out of school. Visitors and Volunteers, including parents/guardians needing to sign a student out, will be required to provide a Driver's License or other state-issued identification, which will be scanned through the School Safe ID visitor management system. You will then have the option to download a Digital Pass on your phone.

## **Attendance Reporting and Dismissal Changes**

If your child needs to miss a day of school, or will be late getting to school, please call the office at 614-450-5400. Our office line has 24 hour voicemail and messages can be left anytime the office is closed. Please call absences in to the office rather than emailing classroom teachers when possible.

Per district policy, if we have not heard from a parent for attendance reporting, our office staff will make contact with parents by email or phone to verify the student's absence.

## General Guidelines-When to Keep Your Child Home from School

The protocol for management of communicable disease in Worthington City Schools is based upon the Ohio Department of Health's guidelines and recommendations. Your child is too ill to go to school if any of the following symptoms are present:

- Temperature of 100 F or above by mouth (Student must stay home until fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication. In most cases this means the student will miss the following school day. Please understand fevers can reoccur within a 24 hour time period and this policy is in the best interest of all students.)
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the past 24 hours (Student must stay home for 24 hours to ensure these symptoms are gone before returning to school.) □ Shortness of breath or increased wheezing during normal activity
- Has a cough that interrupts normal activity
- Pain from an earache, headache, sore throat or recent injury
- Has yellow or green drainage from nose or eye(s)
- Rash over body or localized to one area of the body (A student who shows signs of a communicable disease exhibiting as a rash may return to school once the rash is gone or a doctor's note is presented stating the student may return to school.)
- Fatigue that requires bed rest (common with flu-like symptoms)
- Signs of conjunctivitis such as red, crusty or swollen eyes (Student may return once symptoms have been treated and are gone or a doctor's note is presented stating the student may return to school.)

If your child is ill, please do not send them to school to be checked by the school nurse. Such exposure may be harmful to the child as well as to the children with whom they come in contact.

## **Daily Dismissal Form & Dismissal Changes**

Please complete the Daily Dismissal Plan Google form sent via email as early as possible. This helps ensure our dismissal plans for each student is accurate.

After August 16th, if you need to make changes to your child's dismissal plan, please contact the office at 614-450-5400 by 2 p.m. <u>PLEASE DO NOT EMAIL DISMISSAL CHANGES TO STAFF MEMBERS</u>. This is to make sure no changes are missed in email. Please keep changes to emergency situations due to the interruption this causes in the classroom during the school day.
