

## **Community Engagement Comments** **Perry/Phoenix Middle School**

### General

1. Concerned that expensive decisions are being made based of State Design Manual and not what Worthington needs.
2. Maintain youth safety, such as youth baseball, during construction.
3. If there are multiple administrators, how maintain autonomy between Phoenix and Perry as it related to administrators who have to balance safety concerns in case of an emergency/evacuation/lockdown situation.
4. Four programs is two too many. It will be too much to manage logistically and culturally. Placing Academies somewhere else would be desired. Desires more athletic facilities (football, track, tennis). Feels like we are doing a rural school that lacks decent funding by placing four programs in one building and not providing proper amenities.

### Floor Plan

1. Concerned with how shared administration will affect bell schedule, etc.
2. Concerned instrumental music room not feasible for both sets of students (12 classes per day). Also, concerned with instrumental storage. Need three designated music classrooms. Will we be consulting with music teachers?
3. Desires second floor teacher's workroom.
4. Will sixth grade have homeroom? Is there a sixth grade wing?
5. Concerned with distance from Media Center, art, etc. for Perry students.
6. Maximize the number and accessibility of all gender restrooms.
7. Coordinate use of shared spaces related to arts, student dining, etc.
8. Lots of shared spaces to cause logistical problems.
9. Despite State minimum standards make sure there is ample space to host rich arts classrooms.
