***June 17th-21st (session two) for FEMALE students only going into 5th thru 8th grades for the 2019-20 school year. This will be an all-FEMALE Camp held in room 30 at Worthingway Middle School, 6625 Guyer Street Worthington, Ohio 43085.**

***June 24th-28th (session three) is a co-ed camp for students going into 7th and 8th grade for the 2019-20 school year. Camp will be held in room 30 at Worthingway Middle School, 6625 Guyer Street: Worthington, Ohio.**
