For the 2021-2022 school year, we are asking for your assistance to slow the spread of Covid-19. At this time, we will require all students in grades K-12, whether vaccinated or unvaccinated, to wear face masks.

For those students that are not permitted to wear face coverings for religious reasons, please provide additional information below, sign the form, and return it to your building principal. **Please allow up to three (3) business days for review of and response to this request. Students must wear masks to attend school during this time.**
