# Remote Learning and Hybrid Models

Worthington Schools will begin the year in a “Full Remote” model.

- 1st day of school is Monday, August 31st
- Based upon information from Columbus Public Health, we may move to the “Hybrid” model or “All In” model over the course of the year.

# Worthington Online Learning Academy

- 100% Online Learning provided by Ohio Online Learning Program (OOLP)
- Students may still participate in athletics or extracurricular activities
- Students participating in this program will remain 100% online regardless of which model Worthington Schools is following.

Major updates to be aware of:

- Deadline to apply has been moved to Wednesday, August 19th
- Families must commit to a full semester at the application deadline
- Families may transition to OOLP or to their home school at 2nd semester

# Worthingway Daily Bell Schedule (All In)

- Seven 45-minute periods
- Two 40 minute periods (these are lunch and assist)
- Three minutes to transition between classes

“Assist” is a structured study hall where students can get help from teachers and participate in lessons involving social and emotional skills.

# Remote Learning and Hybrid Models

Worthington schools will follow a daily class schedule during Remote learning. During their scheduled class times, student will be engaged in the following learning activities:

- **“Online Class”** - teachers will conduct their classes live online during each assigned class period.
- **“Independent Learning Time”** - teachers will provide pre-arranged activities, lessons, videos, or assessments for students to perform through Schoology on days when students do not have a particular class.
- **“Connections”** - teachers will identify and work with students individually or in small groups, attend virtual student meetings, or hold virtual meetings with families. This time can be used for “Independent Learning Time”.

# Safety (Hybrid Model)

- Enhanced hygiene protocols including increased hand washing, frequent use of hand sanitizer, and remaining home with any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Masks are required across all school settings (families shall provide face coverings as the schools will have a limited supply).
- Every Classroom will have hand sanitizer stations.
- High touch areas in classrooms (including desks) will be cleaned after each period.
- Physical distancing measures will be in place including “one-way” hall traffic and classroom desks placed 3-6 ft apart.

- Schoology provides teachers with a forum for communicating with students and parents, posting assignments, and assessing student work.

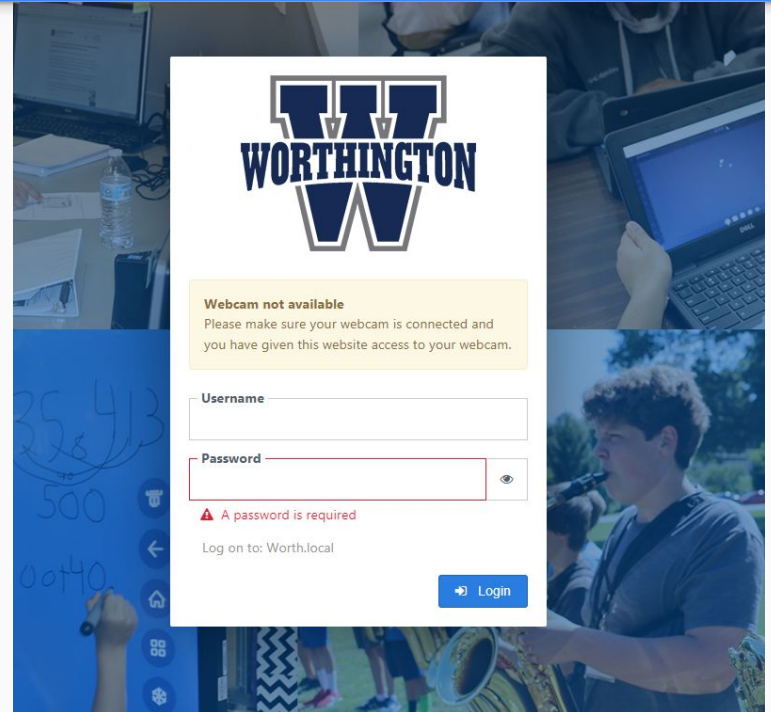
