Student Learning Advocates

These certified teachers are the main contact and support system for students, families, and districts. Student Learning Advocates are provided to each student and family to ensure the student's success.

- System Training
- Goal Setting
- Progress Monitoring
- Tutoring
- Mentoring
- Course Selection



Role of the Student

It is the student's responsibility to:

- Attend Student Orientation
- Log into the platform daily, spending at least one hour per day per course.
- Create a daily routine and stick to it!
- Submit work per your calendar or course report
- Communicate with your course teachers and Student Learning Advocates. Be respectful and use proper email etiquette.
- Do your own work and cite your sources. Do not plagiarize.

- Take digital notes in each course or keep a notebook for each course.
- Follow directions. If you need clarification - contact your teacher via email with the lesson name and what you need help on.
- Check your grades and feedback and make sure to reply and make corrections right away.



Role of the Parent

It is the parent's responsibility to:

- Monitor your child's progress: activity log, grades and feedback, course report, SLA progress updates
- Help create a daily routine that best works for your child and commit to this schedule
- Motivate and encourage your child to stay active in his/her courses
- Maintain communication with SLAs and teachers. A simple "Got it" will suffice.
- Reach out immediately when you have any questions/concerns



Role of the District

It is the District's responsibility:

- Provide student enrollment forms and any schedule changes
- Provide IEP/504 accommodations
- Enforce any school policies
- Review attendance and progress reports
- Apply final grades and credits to student's grade report and transcript
- Administer State Testing
- Provide extra-curricular activities/clubs
- Provide district diploma upon graduation

- Both providers are nationally accredited and courses are NCAA approved.

K-5 COURSE STRUCTURE

- Teach It - instructional video reviewing lesson content.

Read It–this is where the learning begins and you will find all lesson content.

- Show It - this is an opportunity to apply what you learned in the Read It and Watch It. Not a graded assignment.

- **Assess It** - this is a graded assignment that is either teacher-graded or auto-graded.

- **Mastery Assess it** - this is a graded assignment that is either teacher graded or auto-graded. This will assess what you have learned through multiple topics.

6- 12 Curriculum provided by:



- Courses are aligned to Ohio Learning Standards
- Courses facilitated by Ohio certified teachers; a mix of Edgenuity teachers and Worthington teachers
- Courses are enrolled per semester
- Forced-progression
- 6-12 online curriculum - first-time credit, honors, and AP
- Asynchronous courses; Video instructional lectures/modeling by course teachers
- No course materials except for AP courses

Edgenuity (Grades 6 - 12)

Platform features



- Passing course threshold - 60%
- Composing written work - Most essays can be typed into the lesson assignment; lab reports or long-term projects will require use of Word Processing/Google Docs
- Inactivity time - 15 mins for all activities, except for quizzes/tests which have 60 mins
- Enotes/Guided Notes- use on quizzes/tests, not final exam which is cumulative; guided notes follow the instructional lectures
- Text to speech feature
- 2 retries available on all assignments, quizzes, and tests
- Quizzes/tests/Final - timed
 - Quiz- 10 ques, up to 1 hour
 - Unit Test- 25 ques, up to 2 hours
 - Final- 50, up to 3 hours
 - *Once you Save and Exit, any questions you have already viewed will be locked upon return.*
