### **What is the Global Scholars Diploma Program?**

- A credential that recognizes global competency above and beyond the required curriculum at Worthington City Schools;
- Students work with other participating districts in the Columbus area to investigate the work, recognize perspectives, communicate ideas, and take action.

### **How do I receive a Global Scholars Diploma?**

- Complete required blended learning (face-to-face and online) courses through Worthington City Schools all four years;

- Attend face-to-face sessions;
- Explore the world through online, self-paced modules;
- Conduct a capstone focusing on action research or a service-learning project with opportunities to explore the world through international travel or mentorship in a global business setting.
