Tdap and meningitis vaccines will be provided. State law requires all 7th and 12th graders be vaccinated for Tdap and meningitis to attend school.

HPV vaccine will also be available (not required for school attendance).

Parents need to bring:

- Child's immunization records and insurance card (*if available - no child turned away due to insurance status*)
- Custody/guardianship paperwork (*if a parent is not accompanying the child*)
- **To save time**, bring the completed consent form with you to the vaccine clinic. (*Forms are available from the school office or school nurse.*)

No appointment needed.

Clinic may stop taking patients early if it fills.
