



The Arnold Skidmore Chapter of the National Honor Society is now accepting applications for new members. NHS was established in 1921 and over 1 million high school students are currently members of the organization which recognizes students for their excellence in scholarship, character, leadership and service to school and community. By supporting a strong and active NHS, Worthington Kilbourne seeks to elevate our commitment to these values and high student achievement and excellence.

In order to be considered for induction into the National Honor Society at WKHS, a student must have:

- Attained junior or senior class standing;
- Achieved a cumulative unweighted grade point average of at least 3.5 for the Class of 2022, and 3.75 for the Class of 2023 (WK staff voted several years ago to increase the GPA, beginning with this class);
- Attended Worthington Kilbourne High School for at least one semester;
- Demonstrated a commitment to serving our community through service experiences during high school, for a minimum of 10 hours;
- Demonstrated leadership qualities through experiences during high school.
- Demonstrated positive character traits and values, such as integrity, honesty, and personal responsibility.

Students meeting the GPA requirement have already received an invitation to join a Google Classroom to access and complete their application by September 24th. Students should carefully consider whether they meet all of the above criteria before deciding to apply. Student GPA is the first step in eligibility, but submitting an application means that they will now be evaluated in the areas of character, leadership, and service.
