RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education ("Board") hereby finds and determines that it is necessary to reduce non-teaching employees due to budget reductions and a lack of funds. Pursuant to Article 5 of the Negotiated Agreement between the Board and the Worthington Education Support Professionals, the Board has identified those areas in which reductions in staff levels are necessary and has notified the employees who are, or who may be affected by the reductions provided herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

**Section 1.**

The Board of Education hereby finds and determines that it is necessary to reduce permanent classified employees due to budget reductions and a lack of funds. Pursuant to Article 5 of the Negotiated Agreement between the Board and the Worthington Education Support Professionals, the Board hereby finds that it is necessary to implement a reduction in force in each of the following classifications or classification series as follows:

**Section 2.**

The reductions in force provided in this Resolution shall be effective midnight July 31, 2011. **Section 3.**

The Board of Education further finds and determines that it is necessary to abolish the following non-teaching exempt positions based on budget reductions and a lack of funds as follows:
