Children will not be permitted to start 12 <sup>th</sup> grade without proper proof of the immunization. It is advisable to make an appointment for your child to receive these vaccines to avoid exclusion. As soon as your child receives this vaccine, please provide proof of immunization from your physician to your school office so that we can update your child's school health record.
Please notify the Health Office if there is a medical or personal reason why your student cannot receive the Meningococcal vaccine so their health record can be updated or if your student has an upcoming appointment.
